

In Shotgun events there is a possibility to shoot practice rounds 5 € per round (25 birds), and in Running Target event practising costs 8 € (20 shots).

GENERAL INFORMATION

Shootingweek is divided into two periods (1st July-4th July and 5th July-8th July). Shooters can renew their shooting event, i.e. they can shoot as many times as they want to during each period. The best result in each is taken to the result list. Prize ceremonies will be held after each period (on Tuesday 4th July and on Saturday 8th July).

In Rifle and Shotgun events shooters can shoot as "non-stop" i.e. when ever the shooting conditions at the range makes the shooting possible, during the daily shooting time between 10 a.m. and 7p.m. (exception on Thu 6th July when the shooting ends at 6 p.m. due to Shooters' Party). In pistol events (excluding the Air Pistol and Free Pistol which will be shot as non-stop) there are rounds for every Pistol event at certain time of the day. Shooters must sign up beforehand to the Pistol round they are going to participate in. Signing up takes place in the Competition Office at the Shooting range.

Daily shooting time between 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. Please notice that in all events, you must start the shooting before 6 p.m. in order to finish during the daily shooting time. SERVICES AT THE RANGE

Restaurant: there is a restaurant in the shooting cabin from where you can get lunch and cofee/tea/bun etc every day during the Shootingweek. The cabin will be open daily during 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Lunch at 10.30 a.m.-4 p.m.

Toilets and washing facilities: at the range you can find toilets and washing facilities (showers). **Electricity:** if you travel by car and caravan, there is a possibility to overnight at the range and you can also get electricity for use. Cost 10 € per day, is paid to the competition office.

Location: the Shooting range is about 1,5 kilometres away from Karstula centre. Karstula is situated in central Finland, approximately 100 kilometres from city of Jyväskylä. The exact address is Päällinjärventie 22.
